1.2. Rally Description

ROMA - An impressive route to the 6th Rally of Rome Capital, scheduled from 19th to 22nd July 2018, a race having the validity as the stage of the European Championship Rally FIA, the Italian Rally Championship and the Italian Cup - Regional Championship. 36 are Municipalities involved and nearly 1000 kilometers of route with 15 special stages; the event, organized by Motorsport Italia and co-ordinated by the Roman driver Max Rendina, will be the protagonist of a vast territory of Lazio with timed stages that will take place in Rome and in many places in the south of the capital until arriving at the town of Pico. Below the program:

SS 1 – “ACI ROMA ARENA” Km 1.80 Side by Side – Friday 20th July starting from 18:30

It is already a part of a sort of a “legend” of the Rally di Roma Capitale. This special stage attracts an incredible number of spectators. It is assumed that they will be more than 30 thousand.

The challenge takes place in one of the most knowed sites of Rome. The stage starts in the Eur area. Team principal Max Rendina wanted to offer again an opportunity to the italian fans to follow the big show and they have a chance to cheer for their favourites. The cars enter two at a time and they face in a visible way in front of the Square Colosseum in the Eur district. People can see which one between the two crews is going to win. At the end there is an overall ranking. All that does not count in the Rally final results, but it is a great show.

SS 2 / 5 – PICO-GRECI Km 19.46

– Saturday 21st July

first run at 9:54 – second run at 15:58

No doubt: it is a very hard stage. It begins hostilities on Saturday and its result can outline the values in the field. The route is narrow and rough and the driver will make the difference, also because the road profile has little irregularities that test the distribution and the driving accuracy. For the first time they will drive in the opposite direction compared with the past, for about the 80% of the route.

SS 3 / 6 – ROCCASECCA-COLLE SAN MAGNO “POLAR CRUISE” Km 19.93

– Saturday 21st July

first run at 10:49 – second run at 16:53

The tarmac is for a large part in a very good condition, with a lot of grip where it's important keep a good speed. It reminds a bit of the second day of Rocca di Cave special stage, because there is a series of hairpin turns, alternated with some demanding sprints. You climb till about 900 metres above sea level. At the end of the stage things become harder therefore you have to be very careful.

SS 4 / 7 – SANTOPADRE-ARPINO “CIVITUS” Km 14.35

– Saturday 21st July

first run at 11:39 – second run at 17:43

This is a “new entry” for the Rally di Roma Capitale. The stage starts with a good grip on the road, that is long with many a winding turn for a length of about 3,5 kilometres, followed by 2 kilometres of a narrower road, then it widens again passing

very close to the Santopadre residential area with a series of bends, without interruption till the end of the stage. So, you have to drive till the stop sign.

SS 8 – PICO SUPERSTAGE “ECOPETROL” Km 2.54

– Saturday 21st July starting from 19:15

Do not miss that event in the city of Pico, forever a place of a strong rallying passion. You drive for the pleasure to do it in front of people applauding you. The route is circular, so after the start the cars go back to the start line till the end of the stage. It does not count in the Rally final results, but it is forbidden making mistakes losing precious seconds. This is the races rule.

SS 9 / 12 – ROCCA DI CAVE “OMNIA SHIPPING” Km 28.60

– Sunday 22nd July

first run at 10:11 – second run at 14:15

In the first part there are as many as 18 hairpin turns going up. Then, at Rocca di Cave, the road becomes fast and driven till Rocca Santo Stefano where a steep and fast downhill starts, that will make the difference also in consideration of tyres and brakes condition. It is a classic stage of the Rally di Roma Capitale.

SS 10 / 13 – MONASTERO – JENNE “ETORO” Km 12.40

– Sunday 22nd July

first run at 11:02 – second run at 15:06

Also the Monastero special stage is a classic event of the Rally di Roma Capitale. All differences considered, it has a kind of stretches of road which look like the roads of the Tour de Corse. There are some tunnels which pass through the mountain, sometimes to enter and to exit the tunnels there is a turn and that can make the difference between the pilots, because of the change of light and the change of the tarmac temperature. The news of this year is that the stage will not end outside the village of Jenne, as in the past, but it will pass through it with two spectacular inversions.

SS 11 / 14 – GUARCINO “L’AUTOMOBILE” Km 11.75

– Sunday 22nd July

first run at 11:42 – second run at 15:46

The special stage is the same of the past editions. However it is an important date with the stopwatch because the hilly stretch of road is very fast and driven and so cars constantly run at full speed.

SS 15 – SUPER SPECIAL “SKY GATE” Km 0.65

– Sunday 22nd July starting from 19:18

Never say never. The saying is worth also for the last special stage. It will be a sort of kermesse, anyway you can never know. Nowadays the gaps can be very small and so even 650 metres, on Sunday evening, in front of a wider audience for the special occasions could become important and even decisive for the charts. So, at the Rally di Roma Capitale you can never tell... till the end.

5. SERVICE PARK

5.1. Location

Only one Service Park located in Fiuggi will be organised during the Rally.

Surface: tarmac, concrete.

Location: Parking in front of Terme di Fiuggi

Parcheggio Fonte Anticolana - 03014 Fiuggi Fonte (Frosinone)

GPS Coordinates: N 41°47.356' ; E 13°12.828'

5.2. Access

Service Park will be opened from Tuesday, 17th July 2018, 9:00

Service Park can be entered only with competition cars, Service cars (SERVICE plates) and Auxiliary vehicles (AUXILIARY plates).

All plates must be affixed to the upper side of the windscreen on the right (passenger) side. Removal of the sticker is prohibited until the end of the rally.

Reconnaissance cars, VIP vehicles and trailers are not allowed to enter the Service Park. Nearby Parking area will be available for the other registered vehicles (Recce/VIP) and trailers.

5.3. Service Area

The competitor is obliged to service only within the allocated service area in the Service Park. These regulations will be controlled by the Chief of the Service Park. Any infringement in this field will result in charging a double fee for additional service area.

Teams that, due to logistics, need to stay together or having any special requests must send them by E-mail to Team's Relations Coordinator.

At the request of the competitor, in case of the space availability, the Organiser may provide additional area in the Service Park for extra charge (priority will be given to competitors – legal entrants). Additional space can be ordered for a price of 10 € per 1 m².

The Organisers will make ll reasonable efforts in order to satisfy the needs of all Teams.

The Joint Service Request form must be received by Friday, 9th July 2018. No further changes will be accepted after this date.

5.4. Service Park Rules

5.4.1. Maximum speed

Maximum speed inside the Service Park is limited by 30 km/h.

5.4.2. Catering within the Service Park and the Remote Service Zone

Apart from the provision of a catering service for the drivers and service crew personnel of a team, any other form of catering or sale of food and beverages in the service park is prohibited. The only exception is where a written agreement has been entered into between a team and the organisers.

A fine of 1 000 € will be applied in respect of any infringement of this regulation.

The organiser will provide a catering service within the Service Park for all team personnel and spectators.

5.4.3. Shows and exhibitions in service area

If any team or company would like to organise shows or exhibitions for their guests in service area, they must ask organisers for permission before Administrative Checks. All shows and exhibitions in service area without permission of organisers are strictly forbidden.

5.4.4. Tidiness

All crews are obliged to use a liquid-proof tarp under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. The

crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition.

The Organiser will charge a deposit of 50 €. It will be refund after the rally on condition that the service area allocated to the crew will be cleaned.

5.5. Facilities

All FIA ERC registered drivers will have free access to:

- A secured and safe power
- Running water
- Internet connection (WIFI)

The following services will be available for all Competitors:

- General lighting
- General Security
- Public toilets
- Garbage containers and waste collection
- Oil removal

The following extra facilities could be ordered for use in the service area:

- WC for the team's private use
- Electricity
- WLAN
- Fork-lift & Car transport rental
- Exclusive security service for the team

Teams requiring these services are requested to send them by E-mail to Organiser.

5.6. Security and medical services

The service park will have a permanent security surveillance starting from Tuesday, 17th July 2018. Exclusive security service for the team can be hired through the Organisers. A Medical Centre will be established at the service park.

6. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. In order to obtain the license it is necessary to contact the Italian Ministry of Communication. Nevertheless the Organisers are at Competitors disposal for any assistance may be needed. We remind that the use of radio frequencies without license may lead to the prohibition of using the transmitter, as well as a fine and the confiscation of the radio equipment.

7. HELICOPTERS

7.1. Registration

In order to ensure that air traffic may develop in the best safety conditions and according with the FIA Safety Regulations and the Italian Air Traffic Authority, all helicopters wishing to flying over the area of Rally Roma di Capitale during the event, must register at the Rally Organisation.

Only duly registered helicopters will be allowed to fly over the Rally area and land in the helicopter areas or other sites within the competition zone.

7.2. Registration form and procedures

The registration form will be published on website rallydiromacapitale.it. Application form has to be sent to the Rally Office (info@rallydiromacapitale.it) till Tuesday, 9th July 2018.

7.3. Administrative Fee

The Organisers require payment of an administrative fee as refund related to the costs incurred for the management of services to commercial helicopters and teams helicopters exceeding. The amount is 2.500,00 + € 550,00 VAT 22%) for each helicopter. Fee must be paid by Bank Transfer to:

7.4. Briefing

Attendance to the pilots briefing at Rally HQ on Thursday 19th July 2018 at 9:00, is compulsory for all pilots.

Failing to attend the briefing will imply the cancellation from the registered helicopters list and consequently the prohibition to over-fly the rally area. During the briefing all pilots will get stickers with identification numbers that must be placed on the bottom of the helicopter for the entire duration of the event.

8. FUEL / TYRES

8.1. Fuel

8.1.1. Fuel Regulations:

Competitors may refuel their cars only in the refuelling zones (RZ) designated by the organiser in the present regulations and in the road book. Service crews are allowed to fill PUMP fuel in their canisters, and refuel cars only in designated Refuelling Zones.

Fuel for drivers entered in ERC are free. All types of fuel must comply with Appendix J, Articles 252.9.1 and 252.9.2.

Panta Fuel (optional, but recommended), will also available at any RZ. Panta Fuel can be ordered by completing the form available in the rally website and will be distributed directly to rally cars during the rally, in the RZ.

8.1.2. Fuel Regulations for ERC Junior U27:

The use of Panta fuel is compulsory. Panta fuel will be distribute directly to rally cars during the rally, in the designated RZ.

Panta Fuel can be ordered by completing the form available in the rally website; the form has to be sent via e-mail to: fuelorder@panta.it

Competitors are responsible for agreements taken directly with the supplier, as far as concern supply and payment. The price of the fuel including service is € 2,10 per litre (VAT included).

8.1.3. Refueling Zones:

- Refueling will be located 2,63 km after SP out as showed in road book.

Leg 1:

- RZ0 (Before Taking Car to Holding Area) will be located 2,63 km after SP Out (Same Location as QF/FP RZ) from 7.00am until 9.00 am.
- Fiuggi 1,55 km before park fermè In (Section 1)
- Ceprano Located in Piazza Campo Uccelli (Section 2-3-4)

Leg 2:

- Fiuggi 2,63 km after the exit of Service Park
Same place as section 1 Leg 1 and FP/QS

8.2. Tyres:

8.2.1. Tyres specified for use during the rally by all drivers:

All tyres must be readily available commercially and must comply with 2018 FIA RR Sporting Regulations, Article 60 and Appendix V.

8.2.2. Type:

Tyres for tarmac must comply with Appendix V and Appendix J

8.2.3. Barcodes for all types of tyres and all drivers:

Each tyre must have either:

- Two identical moulded barcode numbers (one on each side of the tyre / each barcode having a different colour as defined by the FIA) supplied by the 2018 FIA-approved barcode supplier, or;
- A single moulded barcode number supplied by the 2018 FIA-approved barcode supplier.

These barcodes will be used to check that the same tyres remain fitted to a particular car between tyre changes and that competitors are not exceeding the maximum quantities allowed.

It must be noted that the barcode must be visible from outside the car.

8.2.4. Tyres for reconnaissance:

Only Homologated commercial road tyres are allowed

8.2.5. Tyres marking/control zones:

Tyre Marking Zone during rally will be organised between TC0 and TC1 and at the exit of all TC of the Service Park: TC1D - TC4D - TC8H - TC11D and TC14D.

During the tyre marking procedure crews and up to one team member must provide the scrutineers in charge any assistance required. More specifically, cars must be presented at the tyre marking zone with their spare wheels placed with the outer part of the rim "up", and if needed, unfastened, so that their marking is easier.

Following the marking, and before the cars' departure from the tyre marking area, crews, or their team member, must place the spare wheel(s) properly and fasten them as required.

Tyres will be checked for their conformity during the rally.

10. OFFICIAL PRE-RALLY TESTS

The Organiser of Rally will organise official pre-rally test for competitors entered to the rally, on Tuesday, 17th July. The official Pre Rally Test is located in Rocca D'Arce in the area where there will be Leg 1 of the Rally at about 70 km far from Main Service Park in Fiuggi. The Length of the stage is 3.10 kms.

11. RECONNAISSANCE

11.1. Procedure for registration in Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance registration will take place as follows:

Venue: Rally HQ - Grand Hotel Palazzo della Fonte - Via dei Villini, 7 - Fiuggi Fonte (Frosinone).

Dates and time:

17th JULY-TUESDAY	15:00 – 22:00	Rally HQ
18th JULY- WEDNESDAY	7:00 – 10:00	Rally HQ

Both crew members must be present at the registration as the administrative checks will be carried out at the same time.

At registration a Reconnaissance Card will be issued and has to be filled in and signed with all details of the car that will be used. This card has to be kept inside the car during reconnaissance.

Should a crew's reconnaissance car be replaced for any reason, the Secretariat must be informed of the details of the replacement car.

The identification "R" numbered sticker given at the reconnaissance registration shall be displayed and remain visible during reconnaissance on the top middle part of the windscreen.

11.2. Specific and/or National restrictions

11.2.1 A maximum of **2 (two)** passages is permitted over each SS, the FP/QS and Shakedown during reconnaissance. SS run twice are considered to be one stage.

11.2.2 All passages on the SS, the FP/QS and Shakedown will be recorded by Marshals. NO Time cards will be used.

The maximum speed allowed during reconnaissance on SS is 80 km/h unless another speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or written instructions on the Road book or in a Bulletin. Competitors not respecting the allowed speed limit will be penalized as per Articles 20.2.2 and 20.2.4 of the 2018 FIA RR Sporting Regulations.

11.2.3 Crews are authorised to recce twice SS2 Pico-Greci and twice SS8 Pico Superstage, part of SS2.

11.2.4 Reconnaissance of SSS1-ACI Roma Arena will be carried out as per Article 3 of Supplementary Regulations.

11.2.5 Reconnaissance of SS15 Ostia - Super Special can be performed only on foot, at any time.

11.3. Installation of speed control checking devices for Reconnaissance - Location of collection

All cars must carry "Recce GPS recorders" on board during reconnaissance. The device will be provided by RDS Company during Administrative Checks, on Tuesday 17 or Wednesday 18 July as per Article 3 of the present Supplementary Regulations.

The following rental fees will be charged when collecting the equipment:

- ERC drivers: **€ 200.00**
- Other drivers: **€ 150.00**

11.3.1 Location of return of GPS recorders

GPS recorders for Reconnaissance have to be returned as stated in Article 3 of Supplementary Regulations.

- ASN authorization, for all foreign drivers and co-drivers.
- Other documents to complete the entry details.
- Insurance cover (third parties) for the rally car.
- Insurance cover for repatriation (non-Italian crews).
- Documents and registration papers of the rally car.

13.1.1 General principles

- Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the Team.
- Competitor must show the car's complete certified homologation documents.
- After scrutineering, if a car is found not to comply with technical and / or safety regulations, the Stewards may set a deadline to comply with the requirements otherwise start in the event will be refused.

13.1.2 Sealing and Marking

Car's chassis and engine will be marked as prescribed in Article 26.1.4 of the 2018 FIA RR Sporting Regulations. Sealing of the cars' mechanical components (fitted on the cars and spares) will be carried out according to the 2018 FIA RR Sporting Regulations, Article 63.

All cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials; these parts must be kept in the car for the weighing procedure. Cars and mechanical components must be provided with holes for sealing.

The transmission (fitted on the cars and spares) of non-priority drivers' cars will not be sealed.

13.2 Mud Flaps

Fitting and use of mud flaps, comply with Article 252.7.7 of FIA Appendix J, is permitted but not compulsory.

13.3 Windows / Nets

The use of transparent and colourless anti-shatter films (maximum thickness: 100 microns) is compulsory on side and sunroof windows, unless they are in polycarbonate (see Article 253.11 of FIA Appendix J).

Rear side and sunroof windows may use silvered or tinted films (see conditions below) in replacement of transparent and colourless antishatter films.

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorised, on the rear side windows, on the rear window and on the sunroof, on the following conditions:

- Silvered or tinted films fitted on rear side windows must have an opening equivalent to the surface of a circle of 70 mm in diameter so that the driver as well as the contents of the car may be seen from the outside.

13.4 Driver's Safety Equipment

All items of drivers clothing including helmets and FHR device intended to be used, must be in compliance with FIA Appendix L - Chapter III and will be checked at pre-event scrutineering.

13.5 Fitting of the Safety Emergency Tracking System (2018 FIA RR Sporting Regulations - Article 65.2)

All competitors must arrange their rally car(s) for the mounting a RDS Safety Emergency & Tracking Device. Installation instructions are available in Appendix 5. The correct mounting and functioning of the equipment will be checked at pre-event scrutineering.

RDS Company will require all competitors a refundable credit card deposit of **€ 800.00** when they pick up the equipment.

The RDS Safety Emergency & Tracking Device will be distributed as per Article 3 of the present SR and will be returned at the last SP or in the Final Parc Fermé where the cars must be left open for this purpose.

In case of retirement the equipment must be returned to RDS Company in SP no later than 30 minutes after the publication of the final classification.

13.6 Noise level (2018 FIA RR Sporting Regulations, Article 65.3)

At any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with FIA Appendix J.

13.7 Special and / or National requirements - Cars equipment

Competing cars must be equipped with:

- A reflective triangle.
- One red "SOS" sign and on the reverse a green "OK" sign measuring at least 42 x 29,7 cm (A/3 size).
- Two fluorescent jackets (one per each member of the crew).

13.8. Final Checks

Selected competitors for final scrutineering (Stewards' decision) are requested to provide proper equipment (including all sealed spare parts) and technicians at the final scrutineering venue.

Selected cars have to be driven to the final scrutineering venue by a designated team member (who must be present at the arrival), accompanied by an Official.

14. FREE PRACTICE / QUALIFYING / SHAKEDOWN

14.1. GENERAL

Free Practice and Qualifying Stage will be organised according to the Art. 30 in ERC section of FIA-RRSR.

14.2. LOCATION

Free Practice, Qualifying Stage and Shakedown will be held in Fumone, about 16 km from Service Park in Fiuggi. The stage is 4.02 km in length.

Service Zone for Free Practice and Qualifying Stage, will be located in the Service Park in Fiuggi.

Tyre Marking for this stage will be located just before stage TC.

Exact location of Free Practice / Qualifying Stage is shown in Appendix 3.

15. CEREMONIAL START / RALLY START

15.1.1 Rally cars transfer to Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico by competitors

Competitors are free to transfer the rally cars on Friday 20 July, to Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico by road or transport. The meeting point for all rally cars for the Pre-Ceremonial Start Holding Area is the area called Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico (map will be published in the Service book).

The Itinerary from Service Parc Fiuggi to Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico will be available in the Service book.

Only rally cars or team vehicles carrying Service or Auxiliary pass or transport truck provided by organisers are allowed to enter the Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico as from 12:00.

Team's trucks will be allowed to enter in this area only for the purpose of unloading the competing cars.

Preparation of rally cars can be carried out only in this area.

15.1.2 Rally cars transfer to Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico on Organiser's transporters

A transportation service from Fiuggi-Stadio Area to Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico will be provided by organisers with extra cost of € 200,00.

Any team who might want to use this service shall contact the organisers before Wednesday 18 July, at 21:00.

As from 10:00 on Friday 20 July competitors must drive the competing cars to Fiuggi-Stadio Area for cars loading on the transporters. The loading must be made by a member of each team. No rally cars will be loaded unless a team member is present in order to assure the operation.

Entering Fiuggi-Stadio Area Cars Loading Area outside the indicated time will incur a cash penalty of € 200,00.

As from 11:00 the convoy of transporters will move from Fiuggi-Stadio Area to Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico.

As from 12:00 a representative of each competitor must unload the competing car in Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico (map will be published in the Service book). If during the unloading operations at the scheduled time no team member is present the unloading will be carried out by the transporter being any risk full responsibility of the team.

15.1.3 Servicing in Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico

Teams are allowed to work at any time until the individual start time to Roma-Castel Sant'Angelo, location for Ceremonial Start, at the condition provided for RSZ (2018 FIA RR Sporting Regulations - Art. 52.4).

Any service is forbidden on the car as from the car are started to Roma-Piazza Ugo La Malfa.

15.2. Ceremonial Start-Podium Start Ceremony

The Ceremonial Start-Podium Start Ceremony will take place on Friday 20 July from 16:45 in Roma-Castel Sant'Angelo.

The itinerary from Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico to Roma- Castel Sant'Angelo is included on the Road book and on the Service book.

Team's members will be allowed to drive the competing cars from Via dell'Oceano Atlantico to the Ceremonial start holding area. The individual start time from Roma-Via dell'Oceano Atlantico to Roma- Castel Sant'Angelo is at the competitor's discretion, cars must enter the pre-starting holding area for Ceremonial start at list 60 minutes before their individual starting time.

From the moment competitors arrive at the Ceremonial start area repairs or any assistance will not be allowed.

Access to the Ceremonial Start area is limited to crews, to officials and media, holding a appropriate pass.

15.2.1 Start Order and Intervals for Ceremonial Start

The individual time and order for Ceremonial Start will be published on Thursday 19 July at 20:00.

The organiser reserves the right, in agreement with the 2018 FIA ERC Championship Promoter, to establish the order for Ceremonial Start on grounds of spectator interest.

15.2.2 Rally cars transfer from Podium-Ceremonial Start to Holding Area for SSS1-ACI Roma Arena

The transfer of competing cars from Podium-Ceremonial Start to Holding Area for SSS1 will take place in group of 20 cars, escorted by Motorcyclist of Roma Municipality Police at a moderate speed. Road traffic law must be respected during the whole duration of the convoy. All infringement will be reported to the stewards. After passage on the Podium-Ceremonial Start, each crew must follow the Marshal's and the Motorcyclist instruction, ready to start in convoy to reach Roma-Piazza Barcellona, Holding Area for SSS1.

The Itinerary from Podium-Ceremonial Start to Roma-Piazza Barcellona is included in the Road book.

15.3. Rally Start

A TC0-Start of Section 1, established on Piazza Barcellona and located as shown in the Road book is the Official Start of the rally.

As from 18:15 the cars authorized to start may enter the track before the TC 0 - Start of Section 1 and all crews have to be at Marshals disposal and ready to start, in front of TC0, 10 minutes before their individual starting time.

16. RALLY FINISH

The finish of the rally is at TC 15A, located at Ostia Pontile Principale. From TC 15A up to the finish ramp, competitors will be under parc fermé conditions and must follow marshals' instructions. This area will be open only to Officials holding the appropriate pass and the Media for interviews. Following the finish ramp competitors will drive their cars to the adjacent parc fermé, unless they will be driven to final scrutineering.

For the prize giving the usual ERC procedure will be followed: 3rd / 2nd / 1st overall / 1st ERC team (if any) / rest of competitors in the order of their arrival, including ERC 2 and ERC 3 cars.

APPENDIX 5. FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Tracking GPS System for Reconnaissance



1. During the delivery of the Road Book you will be provided a tracker, in a portable version, to be used during reconnaissance. The Tracking Service for Reconnaissance has a cost of € 200 for ERC 1/2/3 and € 150 for other drivers to be paid at this stage.
2. It is also compulsory to pay a security deposit of € 150 cash. This deposit is for GPS Recce and GPS Race Tracker. This deposit will be returned to you at the end of the event, at the time of the return of the GPS Race Tracker.
3. The delivery and management of the GPS Race Tracker will be made to technical scrutineering.
4. The tracker is used to track your location/Speed in real time and to send an SOS in case of emergency.
5. The tracker will always stay "on" for ALL THE DURATION OF THE RECONNAISSANCE.
6. You can put it in a pocket (well closed), in the purse or inside your backpack. DO NOT place the device under metal surfaces.
7. To send an **SOS** press the key for at least 3 seconds.
8. The device must be charged every day after use.

The GPS Tracking System RDS is a GPS / GSM communication system by which all competitors of a rally are monitored along the route of the special stages and transfers. Data from GPS devices installed on your vehicle are transmitted to the RDS server and made available to the Race Direction for the purpose of monitoring the race for safety reasons and sports. The GPS tracking system is mandatory for all Rally events (please read Regulation ACI Sport Service).

The system Tracking System GPS RDS consists of two devices:



Rally KIT

(purchased and installed by the crew)



BOX GPS

(owned by RDS)

The "Rally KIT" consists of a box with a SOS request button, spies monitoring supply and wiring connection to the Battery, the IGNITION and "GPS BOX" RDS.

The crew will purchase it and install it on the car in a stable and permanent way according to the preferences of the pilot and the navigator, but, in all cases, according to criteria set by ACI Sport Service.

Among the most important indications: the SOS request button must be accessible from both members of the crew and with seat belt.

For the installation, see the documentation provided with the kit.

Before any race, the RDS technical staff will connect your "GPS BOX" with the "Rally KIT".

At the end of the race the "GPS BOX" will be uninstalled and disconnected from the "Rally KIT".

ATTENTION. Both the GPS BOX and the Rally KIT are provided with SOS button. It is reminded that this key must be used exclusively for a possible request for RESCUE. Pressing the SOS button, the Race Direction will be promptly informed about the emergency.

In the GPS BOX there is also the "OK" button to indicate that "at the present there are no alarms or warnings".

Installation and Positioning

Installing the Rally KIT predisposition.

The Rally KIT will be installed by the owner of the vehicle, following the wiring diagram in the package (or they can be downloaded from the site www.rdsitalia.it). In the Rally KIT there is the SOS request button.

The SOS button of the Rally KIT must be easily accessible from both members of the crew with seat belt.



The connector for the GPS BOX (coloured black-blue, in the Rally KIT) has to reach the uppercentral area of the dashboard or, alternatively, the right front roll bar so as to be easily connectable to the GPS BOX.

Installing the GPS BOX.

The BOX GPS will be installed by the staff of Tracking System during the pre-event checking.

Also in this device there is a SOS button and it performs the same function as the one placed in the Rally KIT.

It must be placed under the windshield so as to ensure the proper functioning of the GPS survey ("sky view"). For safety reasons, any other position is not allowed.

It will be positioned on the upper-central part of the dashboard or, alternatively,

on the right front roll bar. The alternative location (roll front right) is to be preferred if and only if the pilot believes that the lights of the SOS buttons and OK disturb driving during the race. It will be returned to staff only after the race.



IMPORTANT:

Under no circumstances it is allowed to tamper with both "Rally KIT" and "GPS BOX". The Competitor and the Organizer agree not to tamper with, intervene, remove and / or physically compromise these devices and their functionality.

Any interference or alteration will cause the reporting of the competitor to the Stewards or the Single Judge for the measures that will be considered most appropriate.

Each technical issue and observation must be addressed to the supplier of the product.

What will the crew have to pay?

- The payment of the Tracking System service is included, unless otherwise noted, in the entry fee to the event.
 - The **Rally KIT** will be bought only once and will be owned by the buyer. The price is **€ 61.00** (€ 50.00 + VAT).
 - For cars from abroad, performing occasionally races in Italy, there is no obligation to purchase the **KIT Rally**. In these cases the **KIT Rally** will be hired for the price of € 15,00. The **KIT Rally** will be returned to RDS only after the race along with the GPS BOX.
 - In any event, during the sport checks, it is also required a payment of **€ 150.00** as deposit (or a document), which will be returned after the race at the time of the withdrawal of the GPS BOX and upon presentation of the receipt issued at the time of payment. Any GPS BOX that, due to majeure force, will not be returned or collected after the race, must be sent to the RDS Srl company via courier and expenses borne by the applicant, within 3 days.
- Upon receiving the GPS BOX, the deposit will be given to the competitor.

Service subscription - Privacy

By subscribing to the event you will automatically accept the privacy legislation linked to the service Tracking System.

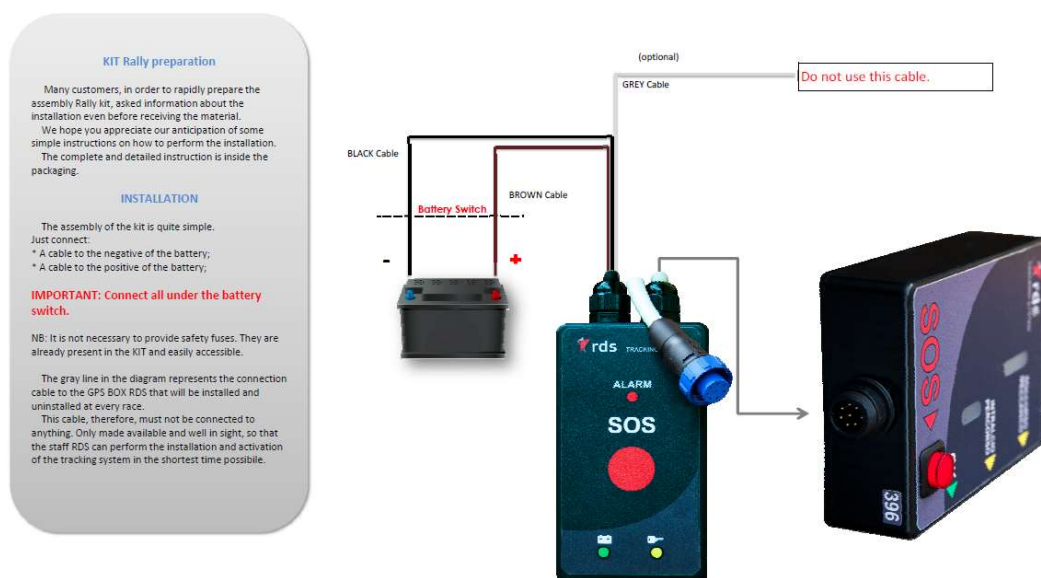
The data collected will be used to carry out properly the service of tracking during the race to which we are about to participate.

This will depend on the location of the areas and how the event is organized.

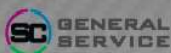
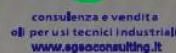
